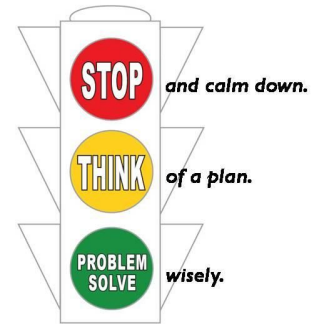


# Stoplight Challenge

**Number of Players:** 2 or more



## How to Play:

One of the players picks a number that is three digits (0-9). The other players take turns guessing numbers until one of them gets it right. The player that is "IT" records the guessed number on a piece of paper or black board and puts a letter beside the number for each digit. **R** for red, **Y** for yellow, and **G** for green.

### Red

No digits are correct

### Yellow

A digit is correct but not in the correct place

### Green

A digit is correct and in the correct position

EXAMPLE: Mystery number: 269

571 (R)

820 (Y)

942 (YY)

429 (YG)

259 (GG)

269 (GGG)

**NOTE:** Always record the letter starting with R first, then Y then G. The *location* of letter does not refer to the location of the digit.
